




Post-Doctoral Position

A post-doctoral position is available in the Borriello laboratory, located in the Department of Cancer and Cellular Biology in the Lewis Katz School of Medicine, Philadelphia (US).

Our lab focuses on understanding the mechanisms of dormancy and metastatic recurrence, with a particular emphasis on the role of the tumor microenvironment. We use a multi-disciplinary approach to study the biology of metastasis, integrating cell signaling, biochemistry, molecular biology, multiplex tissue imaging, several mouse models, and intravital imaging of tumor cells in live animals. - The ideal candidate should have experience in basic molecular and cellular biology methods. Experience with mouse modeling and handling is highly desirable.
- The candidate is expected to be highly motivated, creative, well organized, and capable of contributing productively in a team environment.
- The candidate is also expected to analyze and interpret results, review and present data for publications and presentations, write scientific papers, and engage in departmental seminars and activities.
